

Chapter 66 -- Fireworks

66.010. Penalty for violation. Violation of the Ordinances of this Chapter of the City Code are hereby designated to be misdemeanors, and as such may be punished, upon conviction, by fine of not more than One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) Dollars.

66.020. Specified times. No person shall discharge fireworks of any kind or type, within the City, except on the 3rd and 4th days of July, between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 11:00 P.M.

66.030. Prohibited areas. No person shall discharge fireworks of any kind or type on or within one hundred fifty (150') feet any direction of the City Square, or in the City Park.

66.040. Prohibited on the City streets. No person shall discharge fireworks of any kind or type in or upon the City streets or from any vehicle parked or moving thereon.

66.050. Careful handling required. Any person discharging fireworks of any kind or type, within the City, shall do so in a careful and prudent manner, and shall place, aim, or direct them in such a manner as not to endanger the life, limb, or property of any person.

66.060. Banned under certain conditions. In the event of extreme weather conditions, or water shortage, etc., the Police, upon the request of the Fire Chief may impose a temporary ban on the discharge of fireworks of any kind or type within the City.
